Desired Qualifications (not required):

- ✓ Experience as a teacher or trainer
- ✓ Experience as an adult volunteer in Girl Scouting

Time Commitment:

- ✓ 18-30 hours per year of in-class teaching (3-4 courses)
- ✓ Completion of a Train-the-Trainer course (weekend course)
- ✓ Attend at least one trainer conference or update per year

Other Information:

- ✓ Must complete an application and provide 2 references
- ✓ Have at least 12 months left before PCS or relocation
(At least 2 full training cycles: Fall-Winter and Winter-Spring)
- ✓ USAGSO-NA Trainers may not serve as Overseas Committee Chair (OCC), co-OCC or OCC Elect
- ✓ An adult Girl Scout uniform is required when facilitating in a classroom setting. Uniforms may be purchased "at cost"

USAGSO – NORTH ATLANTIC GIRL SCOUTS PROVIDES:

- Full reimbursement of travel expenses incurred while training for the organization.
- Subsidizing fees for attendance at required trainings and meetings (for North Atlantic trainers only)
- Girl Scout resources and curriculum materials.
- On going educational development opportunities.
