OVERSEAS COMMITTEE CHAIR POSITION DESCRIPTION

Title: Overseas Committee Chair (OCC)

Term: One year. May be reappointed.

Appointed by/Accountable to: Assigned Director of Membership and Marketing/Membership Consultant

Function: To ensure that Girl Scouting is available to all girls in the assigned geographic location. This position is accountable for directing the Overseas Committee in carrying out their Overseas Committee Management Team's (OCMT) *Membership Plan of Work*.

Responsibilities:

Recruit, appoint and facilitate training to an Overseas Committee Management Team reflective of the diversity of the Overseas Committee.

- ◆ Work with the Overseas Committee Management Team to design and implement a *Membership Plan of Work* to recruit and support OCMT members, leaders and girls.

Assure that each person affiliating with the troops subscribes to the purpose, adheres to the policies, and maintains the standards of Girl Scouts of the United States of America.

Secure and endorse the leaders of Girl Scout troops.

- ◆ See that the work of the troops is financed and authorize the methods and manner of collecting funds raised in the name of the troops.

Ensure that Overseas Committee and troops comply with the appropriate military/community regulations.

Represent, interpret, and increase visibility of Girl Scouting to the community.

Qualifications:

Willingness to accept the principles of Girl Scouting and to register as a member of Girl Scouts of the U.S.A.
